 A need to bet more money more frequently
 Restlessness or irritablity when attempting
- "Chasing" losses and loss of control



The Center's Mission

Public Awareness

The Center increased total outreach by engaging 646 organizations and treatment providers to increase capability of treatment and awareness of resources


